

Announcement for the open position of Full Professorship
Tokyo Institute of Technology, Department of Architecture and Building Engineering

1. Position: Professor in Building Engineering

2. Division: Department of Architecture and Building Engineering, Tokyo Institute of Technology

3. Research Field: Concrete Structures

4. Requirements: Applicants should hold a Ph.D. in Building structural engineering (or equivalent) and demonstrate a distinguished academic career, including proof of original research in the building structural engineering, principally in the field of Concrete Structures.

Teaching duties are likely to comprise the full range of Japanese building engineering topics, including Concrete Structures under Japanese Standards. The principal language of instruction is Japanese.

5. Expected Start Date: Position becomes available on October 1, 2013

6. Deadline of Application: 5:00 PM (JST) on June 11, 2013

7. Documents to be submitted:

- 1) Curriculum vitae (since graduation from high school) with photograph, full postal and email addresses, names of all academic degrees with dates awarded, outline of professional career, record of membership and activity in relevant academic societies.
- 2) Full and comprehensive list of published papers and any other relevant professional works, as educational and social activities, prizes/ awards etc.
- 3) Copies of five significant articles (in either Japanese or English).
- 4) List of acquisition of external competitive funds (last ten years, marked as a principal investigator and others).
- 5) Brief statement of research and teaching interests/ achievements, regarding the applicant's past career as well as his/her future perspectives and goals (within 2 pages).
- 6) Contact information including name, affiliation, e-mail address of four reference persons (two in Japan and two out of Japan)
